### COUNCIL CORNER

The municipal office receives many enquiries about vacant lots and new subdivisions in the municipality, and there is continued pressure on our municipality for new subdivisions for summer residences.

At the present time there are before council five applications for subdivisions. Two of these are toward the north end of the municipality, two are in the vehicle restricted area and one is on David Road. If all are approved they will add approximately 110 lots to the assessment roll between 1975 and 1979, approximately 160 new lots were added to the roll.

The process, between the original application, and the final approval of a subdivision, is often a prolonged and time consuming process.

Once the council agrees in principle to a subdivision, the proposal is submitted to the planning branch of the

Provincial Department of Municipal Affairs. From there it is circulated to various provincial departments such as environment, water resources, health, hydro, etc. for their comments. The planning branch returns the proposal to the council with their recommendations approved.

The council then enters into discussions with the developer regarding a development agreement. This agreement will include clauses regarding dedication of land for public use, specifications for roads and lanes, water supply, sewage disposal, lighting and hydro supply, drainage, and any other matters which council or the developer feel should be included.

When this agreement is accepted by both parties, final approval to proceed with the subdivision is given.

When considering subdivision proposals the council consults the "I and Use Study for R.M.V.B." a document prepared by the Provincial Municipal planning branch in 1978 as a guideline for the municipality.
