COUNCIL CORNER

Waste Disposal

It is not a delightful topic to talk about garbage at any time. We all contribute to it and it has to be disposed of somewhere. Garbage in the R. M. of Victoria Beach is picked up by a private contractor who deposits it in a dump on Traverse Bay Road. Our Public Works Foreman Will Anderson did an admirable job of organizing and removing refuse in the past few years. This year Rick Monkman has the contract and is handling it adequately in spite of the fact that Will is a tough act to follow.

May we remind you that garbage is removed weekly. The following is the schedule:

MONDAY — Centre Ave., Gibson Dr., Bayview, Thornton, Sunset, First Ave., Sixth to Eighth Aves., Permanent Residents, Hampton Sub., McCord Sub., Doerksen Sub and Albert Beach.

TUESDAY — Second to Fifth Aves., Birch and Wanigan

On long weekends pickup will be one day later. Garbage must be kept in properly covered containers, garbage bags must be in the containers and they should be left in an easily accessible place but not on the street. If on your garbage day you were to bring your garbage cans toward the front of your lot you would not only be ensuring that your garbage can be located but also you would be assisting us to keep your garbage removal costs as economical as possible. Removal of roofing, boards or any other types of building material is the responsibility of the owner and must be kept on the owner's property until disposed of. Leaves are not garbage and will not be removed as such. Dead fish should be buried and should not be placed in garbage containers.

Brush

It is our desire that the brush piles be removed in June and September. By doing this we hope to keep your streets

Inking neat and tidy

This has not been a normal year. The windstorm that occurred in the third week of June blew down hundreds of trees. The disposal of the debris from these trees has presented an almost insurmountable burden to our contractor. Anyone who walks down our streets is well aware of the piles of brush that have accumulated. It seems that for every pile that is removed two more appear. Because of the windstorm, the removal of brush and leaves will continue until the job is done. Hopefully, by the time you read this most of the streets will have been completely cleared. In case there is another windstorm that causes a number of trees to come down, here are a few helpful hints for you that will assist us to get rid of your brush as quickly as possible:

- tree trunks should be limbed
- limbs should be cut in 5' lengths
- trunks should be cut in 3' lengths
- when you hire a private contractor to remove a tree, ask him to remove the waste portion to the dump

The normal instructions that ask you to avoid piling brush on rocks, water lines, between trees or in lanes are valid ways that you help. Adherence to these instructions will ensure the quick, orderly removal of leaves and brush.

Your Council has approved an extra expenditure of \$2000.00 to complete the removal of the brush caused by the June storm. If we all do our part, we will be able to keep the cost within this extra expenditure. Thank you for your help!
