JUNIOR GOLF TOURNAMENT

The annual Victoria Beach Junior Golf Tournament will be held Tuesday, August 4, 1981 with tee off time scheduled for 12:30 p.m. The competition is open to girls and boys 17 years of age and younger who are Victoria Beach club members. Golfers should arrive approximately 30 hours in

advance to allow the participants to gather on the respective tees for the shotgun start.

To enable the committee to arrange the draw in advance golfers are asked to pre-register at the Victoria Beach Pro Shop.

Scorekeepers are required to accompany each foursome and any adults willing to assist are asked to leave their name with Lloyd Smith at the Pro Shop.

GRAND AGGREGATE

Each year, there are trophies given to the outstanding male and female athletes of Victoria Beach. Points are awarded according to place of finish for five events, which are the 800 metre swim, the bike race, the cross country run, the golf tournament and the tennis tournament. For first, second, third and fourth places, 10, 7, 5 and 3 points are awarded respectively. One point is given for participation. One must also participate in three events.

After the 800 metre swim event, the grand aggregate standings are:

10 pts.: Female — Tammy Nelson, Male — Bob Moody.
7 pts.: Female — Sherry Nelson, Male — Kevin Nelson.
5 pts.: Female — Heather Copland, Male — Tyrone Rogers.
3 pts.: Female — Norma Sweetland, Male — John Rogers.

All athletes who participated in the swim event but did not place to the fourth position overall are awarded one point each.

The next grand aggregate event is the bike race being held this weekend.


