

## Biting Fly Study

Dr. Jack Vallentyne is an ecologist who doesn't like stable flies. These are the pesky little fellows that go for people's ankles on the beach. Maybe you know them. They look like house flies, but are smaller and bite.

Dr. Jack's aim is to reduce the number of stable flies on Albert Beach. This August he will be trapping flies on variously coloured fibre glass panels coated with *Tanglefoot*. *Tanglefoot* is the sticky material rimmed around the trunks of elm trees to trap the beetles that transmit Dutch Elm disease. People can help by not interfering with the stable fly traps.

The study, which will continue next year, is supported by the Canadian Department of Fisheries and Oceans. Dr. Vallentyne is a summer resident of Albert Beach. For further information he can be reached at 756-2001.


