



1995 promises to be another action-packed year for the Victoria Beach Sailing Club. Below, I have listed some of the highlights, along with the results of the 1994 racing season.

Sailing Schools

Craig Baker, a MSA (Manitoba Sailing Association) certified instructor, has been hired for a five-week period, commencing on July 10, to teach our youngsters to sail the Optimist dinghy. Our fleet of Optimists was increased from three to four this year, through the efforts of our club members, who gave their time, working at bingos, in order to raise the necessary funds for the purchase. I think that says a lot about the club members' interest in youth development at Victoria Beach.

From July 17-21, an adult sailing school will be hosted by the Sailing Club. The training boat used for these lessons is the Laser II. Again, these lessons will be taught by a MSA certified instructor, and certificates will be awarded to those qualifying at the various skill levels.


